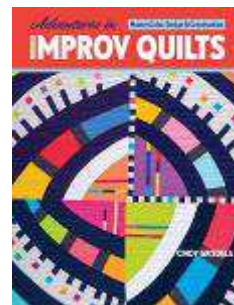
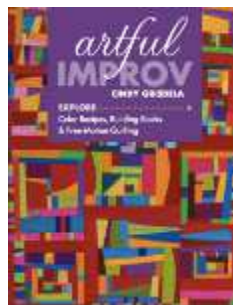

Our next pickup/drop off is on February 22nd from 11:00-1:00pm. We will have quilt tops to make, quilts that need quilting, pillowcases, and raffle tickets.
